
### **PRAYERS FOR PEACE**

# **SUNDAY SCHOOL**

Due to the Sundays when we sometimes have only one child for Sunday School we are entering a time of discernment about our children's provision on Sunday mornings. We have three faithful and diligent Sunday School leaders who take it in turns to lead the classes alongside a PVG checked elder. We recognise if there is only one child, this can be a bit intimidating, and a bit disheartening for leaders to prepare a lesson and have no children appear.

For now, in consultation with parents, we are planning one lesson per month and a seasonal craft activity that will be started on a fixed date and can be continued if children arrive on the other Sundays.



All are invited to join in the services of Wednesday Worship at 5.15 pm each week in term time in the University Chapel.


Do come along and enjoy this time of spiritual nourishment, which is followed by tea/coffee and biscuits - sustenance for the body as well as the soul!
