

PSALM 27

- The Lord is my light and my salvation; 1 whom shall I fear? The Lord is the stronghold of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?
- 2 When evildoers assail me to devour my fleshmy adversaries and foesthey shall stumble and fall.
- Though an army encamp against me, my heart shall not fear; though war rise up against me, yet I will be confident.
- One thing I asked of the Lord, 4 that will I seek after: to live in the house of the Lord all the days of my life, to behold the beauty of the Lord, and to inquire in his temple.
- For he will hide me in his shelter 5 in the day of trouble; he will conceal me under the cover of his tent; he will set me high on a rock.

- 6 Now my head is lifted up above my enemies all around me. and I will offer in his tent sacrifices with shouts of joy: I will sing and make melody to the Lord.
- 7 Hear, O Lord, when I cry aloud, be aracious to me and answer me!
- 8 'Come,' my heart says, 'seek his face!' Your face, Lord, do I seek.
- 9 Do not hide your face from me. Do not turn your servant away in anger, you who have been my help. Do not cast me off, do not forsake me. O God of my salvation!
- If my father and mother forsake me, 10 the Lord will take me up.
- Teach me your way, O Lord, 11 and lead me on a level path because of my enemies.
- Do not give me up to the will of my adversaries, 12 for false witnesses have risen against me, and they are breathing out violence.
- I believe that I shall see the goodness of the Lord 13 in the land of the living.
- Wait for the Lord; 14 be strong, and let your heart take courage; wait for the Lord!


